From this Sunday, and for a week, 24 young people (some who were in Rome in April and some new ones), will meet in Vienna, Austria, to work on their own antimilitarist campaigns!

Participants are coming from Ireland, Belgium, Germany, Turkey, Italy, France, the UK, Kosovo, Spain, Greece, Cyprus, Malta, Georgia, Austria, Albania!!

Here are some of their campaigns: for Spain to recognise Palestine as a state, to launch a queer antimilitarist writing collective, to demand transparency around weapons sales by the EU, for more antimilitarist education in Cyprus...

Youth Leader Fund for a World without Nuclear Weapons - Apply!

Eligibility: Aged 18-29, open to candidates from all countries and territories. Proficiency in English is required.

Focus: The United Nations Office for Disarmament Affairs (UNODA) and the government of Japan are calling on young people to apply for an innovative learning programme "Youth Leader Fund for a World Without Nuclear Weapons". The new learning programme is aimed at equipping the leaders of the future with the knowledge, skills, and network to join global efforts to eliminate nuclear weapons – the most dangerous weapons on earth. The programme is seeking youth who are motivated to use their talents to promote change for a more peaceful and secure world.

Eligibility: Women-led peacebuilding organisations in countries affected by violent conflict, extremism, and militarism
