No War Anywhere!

The second activity of the project - the training on advocacy and campaigning in Austria - finished about two weeks ago. We had 24 participants from 14 countries (Ireland, Turkey, the UK, Italy, Belgium, Kosovo, Spain, Georgia, Greece, Cyprus, France, Albania, Austria and Germany) and from 12 partner organisations (VSI, FoR Wales, SCI-IS, GAIA, SCI France, ADESI, SCI Catalunya, YEU Cyprus, SCI Austria, SCI Hellas, EBCO Greece).

Some participants came from other organisations ([Un Ponte Per](#), [antimilitaristische aktion berlin](#), Don Bosco) and this might be the beginning of new partnerships!

2023 Hiroshima ICAN Academy - Apply!

Eligibility: individuals younger than 25 (some exceptions were made in the past)

Focus: Are you interested in learning more about nuclear weapons, understanding their devastating consequences, and learning how YOU can make a difference?

The Academy 2023 is planned to be held in three sessions: "Online Learning and Webinar Session", "Hiroshima Session" and "Online Reflection Session". Participants are expected to complete all three. Travel costs are not covered, but you can look into getting funded.

Deadline: July 31, 2023

Eligibility: individuals or groups/organisations

Focus: Do you have an imaginative, non-violent project on feminist anti-militarism and anti-war activism? The Maypole Fund may be able to support your activism with a grant of up to £1000
